## **OBJECTIVES AND POLICIES**


- The fund invests in companies in the sectors renewable energy, eco-friendly products and services, organic food, environmental rehabilitation, regional economic cycles and humane working conditions.
- The fund invests not in the nuclear industry, chlorine chemistry, genetic engineering, overexploitation, animal testing, child labor and military technology.

Investment process: The investment committee of eleven members decides from the available universe. It checks the compliance with the investment criteria and develops them further. It decides on new admissions and separation of companies in the universe. The ÖKOWORLD sustainability analysis provides the suggested titles for the investment universe. The committee includes representatives of environmental, human rights and consumer organizations as well as experts in ecological and socially responsible economy. The ÖKOWORLD fund management chooses exclusively from the developed investment universe. Thus, the investment process is separated.

The income of the unit class C will be reinvested annually. Investors can sell their shares in principle every trading day. You will find further details in the prospectus in section "The Shares".
